International trade increases human welfare but also leads to the introduction and establishment of nonnative invasive species, such as human and livestock diseases, pests and diseases of crops, and species that cause environmental harm. The increasingly global nature of trade means that efforts to prevent the spread of invasive species should be internationally coordinated.

The problem of harmful species introductions calls for global solutions. However, the problem also can be addressed in numerous bilateral and regional forums. Examples include negotiations on trade liberalization,
